




IB BASED CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION

ABGS Teachers attended IB content specific training and worked diligently to develop Units of Inquiry across all core content areas. The units are standards based, comprehensive and involved the collaborative effort and ideas of the teachers of ABGS. At the core of the units are Power standards that were used to reinforce areas identified through analysis of NYS assessment data.

Additionally, teachers attended a 2 day Summer Learning Institute that highlighted IB principles of Growth Mindset and Understanding by Design (UBD) model. IB Professional learning will be on-going and targeted to meet the learning needs of all faculty.
