The Nassau County Police Department (NCPD) would like to bring the public's attention to an alarming trend of brightly colored versions of the dangerous narcotic Fentanyl. The Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) has noticed an increase in "rainbow fentanyl" pills and powder that come in a variety of bright colors, shapes, and sizes. Some versions of this drug are shaped to resemble sidewalk chalk. This is a deliberate effort by drug traffickers to drive addiction among children.
