- o documents your learning progress over time
- o provides evidence of meeting professional standards
- o enhances communication and organizational skills
- o greater awareness of strengths and weaknesses
- encourages reflective self-inquiry
- illustrates good teaching
- supports professional growth
- o leads to goal planning
- o visible collection of skills to present to a prospective employer
- celebrate accomplishments
- improves teaching
- o often considered authentic assessment
