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School Success Team SST Overview

The student Success team (SST) is a positive, team-oriented approach to helping students with a wide range of concerns related to their school performance and experience. The purpose of the SST is to identify and intervene early in order to create a support system for students having difficulty in the general education classroom.

Either a staff member or parent can make a referral for an SST. The SST is different than a parent-teacher conference which focusses on improving communication and addressing specific class problems. The team usually consists of a parent, teacher(s), administrator, social worker, and counselor from the school.

The SST meeting provides everyone with an opportunity to share concerns and develop a plan. The interventions agreed upon will vary depending on the child's needs. The SST is an effective way to bring together all resources in the best interest of helping students reach their potential.
