Award: (2) Statewide Scholarships in the amount of \$5,000 and \$3,000

NYSIR – The Joseph Goncalves Student Humanitarian Scholarship Due: March 27, 2020

Criteria:

• Applicant must be a graduating senior who plans to attend college in New York State. • Must demonstrate a record of involvement and work for a cause or organization that actively promotes social justice, equal opportunity, relief of human suffering or similar aspirations generally understood to be within the meaning of humanitarian activity. • Must write an essay (not to exceed 650 words) on an assigned topic. • Applications available in the Guidance Office. Herb Grayson Memorial Scholarship Due: April 3, 2020

Criteria:

- A \$2,000 scholarship will be awarded to one or more graduating Nassau or Suffolk County High School senior(s) chosen based on involvement in and service to the Long Island running community. • In order to qualify for the Scholarship, you must submit a paper describing your involvement in and service to the running community, as well as your personal running accomplishments. • Come to Guidance for application and more information. Criteria:

 - Submit an essay between 500 and 750 words in MS WORD

- Award: Multiple awards from \$750 to \$2,000

The Camilla G. Belser Memorial Scholarship Fund Due: April 19, 2020

Criteria:

- Applicant must be a graduating high school senior residing in Nassau or Suffolk County
 - Applicant must have been accepted to Nassau or Suffolk Community College (other accredited two-year colleges will be considered)
 - Must demonstrate financial need; a copy of your FAFSA Student Aid Report (SAR) must be submitted with the application
 - Must be available for an interview with the Program Chairperson if deemed necessary
 - Include a copy of SAT or ACT Scores and official transcript or GED with scores
 - Copy of college acceptance letter, your resume, 2 letters of recommendation and your essay/personal statement

- Award: \$2,500 annual renewable scholarship
