<u>Unit 2 Overview:</u> In this unit, students are developing a rich life of nonfiction reading by addressing essential foundational skills. You will teach youngsters that skilled, nonfiction readers, read with fluency, taking in long stretches of text, and pausing when necessary to grasp what the author highlighted as especially important. Readers then construct mental summaries of the text, complete with big ideas and supporting information. Your readers will learn to read expository non-fiction with eagerness, interest, and fluency. They will be able to identify the main ideas and supporting information, while recognizing the text infrastructure. Your students will compare texts, think critically, and apply what they have learned as they read independently.

<u>Essential Questions</u>: What are the main ideas and key details when reading a nonfiction expository text? How does the reader summarize and communicate what they've learned from a nonfiction text? How does the reader acquire and use new vocabulary in real-life settings?

<u>Concept Understanding</u>: Students will be able to identify main idea, key details, and add onto this information as they go from section to section. They will be able to recall key details and analyze how these details support the main idea. Students will be able to respond to what the text teaches, question the information they are reading and have partner conversations as they explore the topics. Students will use strategies (new or learned) to assist them in understanding new vocabulary. Students will have partner conversations about the nonfiction topic being studied, in order to practice using their newly acquired vocabulary with accuracy.
