The Hempstead Union Free School District's efforts to improve its schools have made a positive impact on scholars' academic growth. All schools and the district overall are now in GOOD STANDING with the New York State Education Department! This great feat is attributed to our school community and stakeholders working together to ensure we created a strong educational atmosphere and safe environment for our scholars. For the 2024-2025 school year, the district will continue to focus its fiscal and human resources on providing scholars with the skills and strategies needed to prepare them for college, career, and success in this everchanging world.

As in previous school years, the district will continue to offer scholars a wide variety of well-rounded and challenging programs, such as International Baccalaureate Framework (IB), Advanced Placement Courses, Smart Scholars, STEM, Bilingual Classes, FLES, Jr ROTC, Career Technical Education, and Music and Arts. Expanding on these opportunities will give our scholars a chance to rise above their peers and prepare them for their future endeavors of post-secondary education and life. During the 2024-2025 school year, we will be adding the teaching of an all-inclusive account of American History using the BH365 curriculum for Black History and Latin History. Some of our scholars will also be exposed to the importance of agriculture as it relates to wellness and financial literacy. To create a better culture and climate for our scholars, there will be a districtwide implementation of Restorative Practices.

Thanks to the overwhelming support of our community, again, we were able to pass a bond that will address the needs of our facilities. In the next few years, all of our schools will be 21st century, state of the art buildings and will be properly heated in winter and cooled in the summer. As we open the school year, you will see a lot of construction happening in our schools as we continue to address the scope of work approved in the 2022 bond, and now in the 2024 bond. Shortly, work will begin on the new addition to the ABGS Middle School. As a result, we will have to change entrances and exits, as well as reroute our buses and other scholar drop off locations. More information regarding these matters will be addressed by the middle school administration and central office to ensure a smooth transition.

As always, I am truly grateful to our Hempstead Staff and Board of Education for their commitment to the progress our district is making academically, socially, and fiscally. We remain committed to serve our scholars with dignity and respect, as we hold them accountable to high standards and expectations in a supportive, positive, and safe learning environment. This is why we will be enforcing our district's policy (no. 5695) of no cell phone use during the school day. Many studies have confirmed cell phones are an impediment to learning and school safety. Therefore, it is the expectation that our scholars will adhere to the policy and procedures as outlined by their building principals as they return to school this Fall.

The Hempstead UFSD remains dedicated to creating an educational system where scholar's success is inevitable. We will continue to take measures to ensure that our scholars are ready to learn and maximize their potential every day! This year, it is all about #IMPACT!

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




