

**Unit Overview:** The start of first grade is a time for dusting off the skills and habits that children learned during Kindergarten. The theme “readers have good habits” unites all the various strategies you will be giving kids so these skills are instinctive. At the start of this unit, you’ll remind readers about the good habits they already use at the beginning, the middle, and the end of books. For example, you will remind them to preview books so their word work happens with an awareness of the entire story. First graders must become more efficient and flexible word solvers. Later, you will emphasize word solving as you teach your students to draw upon good habits for getting unstuck as they read. Once students begin to develop those good habits, you’ll establish ability-based partnerships that tap into the social power of peers working together to help each other become more strategic readers.

**Essential Questions:** How can I use what I already know about myself as a reader to become an even stronger reader? How can working with a partner make me a stronger reader? How can I read, problem solve hard parts, and talk about books during partner time?

**Concept Understanding:** Students will read with purpose, using and applying reading strategies to increase automaticity, and make movies in their minds as they read.
