- 3. For EPE enrollment, only NRS-eligible students will be counted. Please see note #5 for more details.
- 4. HSE-related statistics are derived by a quarterly data match between ASISTS and the HSE database managed by NYSED.
- 5. NRS refers to the National Reporting System. Students meeting the criteria of NRS eligibility should have received services of 12 or more hours and be pre-tested using the TABE, BEST Plus or BEST Literacy tests.
- 6. POP refers to the Period of Participation. The same student may have multiple POPs if she or he left the program and returned.
