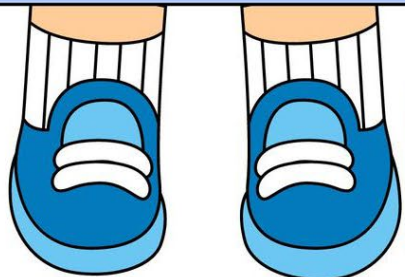

Mrs. T's 1st Grade Student

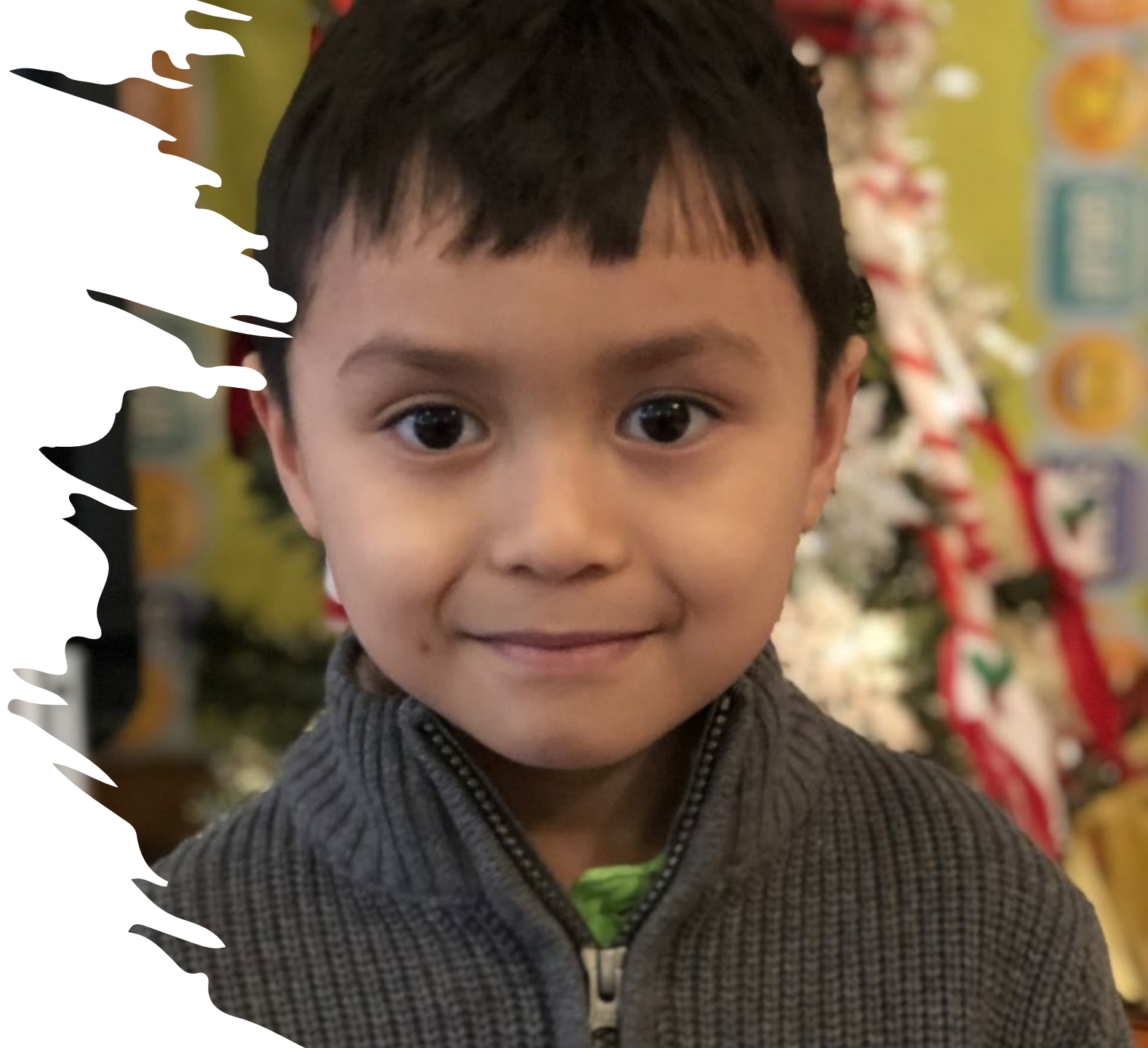

5th Grade Student***

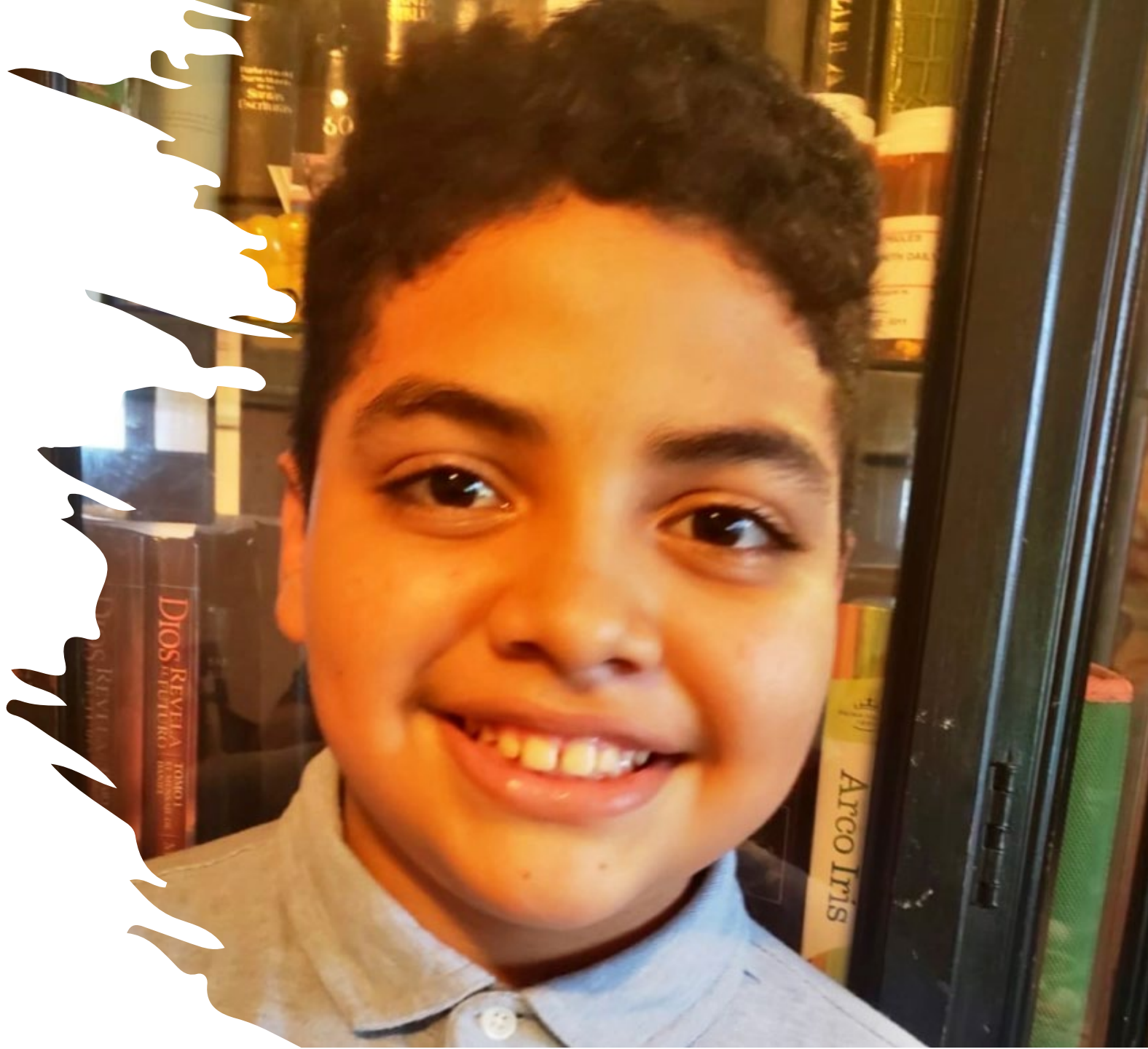
