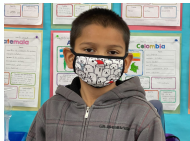
JONATHAN HERNANDEZ

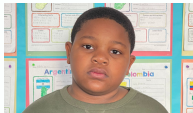
YEFERSON BONILLA
