Pre-K School Hours

School hours are from $\underline{8:30 \ A.M.}$ to $\underline{2:30 \ P.M.}$. Our AM session is from $8:30 \ am-11:00 \ am$ and PM session is from $12:00 \ pm-2:30 \ pm.$

Kindergarten School Hours

Breakfast 7:55am-8:20am

Please be advised that coming to school on time is important for the child's smooth transition into class. Please pick-up your child on time as well. In the event of weather-related of school closings or delays, please watch the local news for more information as well as listen out for the District phone blast.



Attendance

Every day of school matters. Attendance is taken every day. If your child is sick and cannot attend school, please notify the school as soon as possible and upon the child's return please provide a written parent note. After three consecutive days of absences, a doctor's note is required.



Clothing

Please be aware of the District uniform policy. At Marshall School we ask that students wear royal blue tops and navy bottoms.

Please label your child's clothing, including jackets, hats, and other outerwear.

Additionally, families must supply 1 set of clothing, including socks and underwear, labeled with their child's name. Clothes provided must be weather appropriate. Here are some suggestions for attire that will help build independence:

Sneakers/shoes with Velcro Pants that have adjustable sides (so that belts are not needed)

Arrival and Departure Procedures

A child <u>is not permitted</u> to leave with any person other than those designated in writing on the Emergency Contact sheet.

<u>Photo identification</u> will be checked for any designated person picking up a child. Children will not be released to people who do not present identification.

No person under the age of 18, including family members, may pick up your child.

If there are any changes to those who are authorized to pick up your child, please change the <u>Emergency Contact</u> sheet immediately.

PRE-K

Please make sure your child has on his/her bus tag and bag. If your child loses a tag, please notify the teacher immediately.

Please wait behind the gate area while we are in our arrival/dismissal process. Also, please refrain from walking on the sidewalk where our buses are parked during our arrival/dismissal process.

If your child rides the bus, please make sure you give the bus a few minutes before and after your scheduled time to arrive. Bus times are estimates. Arrival time will be affected by traffic and weather conditions. The bus company, Independent Coach, can be reached at

Meals

Our schools provide a healthy and nutritious breakfast and lunch to children every day. Every household please complete a School Meals Application Form, sent home with your child at the beginning of the school year. Any known food allergies and/or copies of any restricted diet approved by the child's physician must be on file at the school. It is the parents'/guardians' responsibility to disclose the child's food allergies.

English Language Learners (ELLs)

Our school will support English Language Learners by providing translations when available, opportunities to engage in social conversations with teachers and peers, print rich in English, applicable ENL services and differentiated learning opportunities catered to the needs of each English Language Learner.



Trips
