United Martial Arts (UMA) will provide 9hours of after-school martial arts instruction five days per week (Monday – Friday). As such each student needs a personal uniform and gloves, which the school has agreed to provide. Gloves provide hand protection while participating in the program and uniforms are important to create an atmosphere of discipline and respect. Additionally, uniforms show the growth of our students. Promoting students to new ranks provides positive reinforcement for progress. As students advance and demonstrate exemplary leadership, new belts will be provided by UMA at a cost of \$80,000.
